Uvalde Health Authority COVID-19 Vaccination Registration

To Register:

■ Individuals who do not have internet access may call the registration hotline at 830-407-8022. The hotline will be answered during business hours, M-F 8am-5pm. After business hours, callers can leave a message with their registration information and they will be added to the registry the following business day.



At this time, only individuals in the following categories may receive the vaccine, per State of Texas criteria:

- Healthcare workers,
- Residents of long-term care facilities,
- Individuals age 65 and over,
- Individuals 16 or older with conditions that put them at a greater risk of severe disease or death from COVID-19.

This Uvalde Health Authority registration portal will automatically prioritize registrants based on the State's mandates. As vaccines are received within Uvalde County, individuals who are next on the registration list will receive an email with their location for vaccination (UMH, CHDI, H-E-B, etc.) and a sign-up link for their date/time. Typically, the sign-up slots will be for the following day.

Things to Remember:

- Uvalde Health Authority has no way of estimating when vaccines will arrive, nor how many will arrive at a given time. The State of Texas does not currently provide this information.
- Getting vaccinated is voluntary. Individuals are not required to register or receive the vaccine.
- Patients will not be charged for the vaccine.
- You do not have to live in Uvalde County to register.
- The vaccines may be available at various places in Uvalde County including pharmacies, physician offices, Uvalde Memorial Hospital, and Community Health Development, Inc. This is determined by the State of Texas.
- It is possible that the State of Texas may release their own vaccine registration portal at a later date. This is something they have not yet determined. If that happens, individuals in the Uvalde Health Authority registration system will be notified and directed to the State's system.
