

## RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the Live Oak County Commissioners Court Reaffirming our Support for the United States Constitution and the Rights and Liberties Contained Therein.

WHEREAS, we hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men and women are created equal, that they are endowed by the Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness; and

WHEREAS, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; and

**WHEREAS**, for the benefit and protection of all people, these unalienable rights are enumerated and enshrined in the Constitution and Laws of the United States and the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Live Oak County Commissioners Court have taken a sacred oath to preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution and the laws of the United States and of the State of Texas;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, we, the members of the Live Oak County Commissioners Court, hereby

- Reaffirm our sacred oath to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution, the Bill of Rights, and laws of the United States and the State of Texas.
- 2) Pledge that in our role as a Commissioners Court-through setting policy, writing budgets, and directing county resources-all Constitutional rights will be preserved, protected, and defended.
- 3) Support our duly elected Live Oak County Sheriff in his efforts to keep the peace, enforce laws, and safeguard the safety of the people of Live Oak County while simultaneously preserving, protecting, and defending the Rights of our citizens as guaranteed in the Constitution and Bill of Rights of the State of Texas and of these United States.
- 4) Pledge that we will continually work to ensure that Live Oak County is a community where Constitutional rights, freedoms and liberties are preserved, protected, defended, and passed on to the next generation, so help us God.
